

At last, I felt very happy and excited but tired. We came back to school at half past five by school bus. I learned a lot of things about animals and farming during the trip. I want to go there again with my family.





Chinese White Dolphins in Hong Kong




I will recommend the Hong Kong Science Museum to all my friends, teachers and neighbours so that they can know this interesting place in Hong Kong.

The second best food in Hong Kong is noodles. You are free to choose the ingredients. You can make your own bowl of noodles!




